Since our humble beginnings in a boarding house in 1908, CaroMont Health has been this region's healthcare provider. Since that time, the health system has continued to evolve and expand to meet the needs of the communities we serve. Our most recent commitment, which includes a second hospital, represents the largest capital investment by any company in the history of the county.

CAROMONT REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER-BELMONT

The new medical campus in Belmont will be anchored by CaroMont Regional Medical Center-Belmont, an acute care hospital with 78 patient rooms, including an emergency department, a maternity unit, operating rooms, and robust diagnostic and imaging services.

Early estimates suggest the hospital alone could create as many as 300 new jobs and see as many as 20,000 patients in the first year of operation.

MEDICAL PAVILION AND BELMONT SURGERY CENTER

The campus in Belmont will also include a four-floor Medical Pavilion with an ambulatory surgery center and various medical specialties. Belmont Surgery Center, a multi-specialty ambulatory surgery center, will bring together the region's top orthopedic and spine surgeons to provide exceptional care and treatment.

CAROMONT REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER-MAIN

CaroMont Regional Medical Center is also growing with the construction of a 104-bed tower on the main campus in Gastonia. The state-of-the-art South Tower expands hospital capacity for seriously ill patients, while prioritizing care for patients and comfort for families.

The Challenge

With the rapid growth of the Charlotte region and escalating changes in local and national healthcare workforce availability, competition for qualified healthcare professionals is accelerating at a concerning pace. Our ability to continue to offer exceptional healthcare will depend upon our success in attracting, training and retaining healthcare providers at all levels.

The American Hospital Association describes the healthcare workforce issue as critical and indicates "the incredible physical and emotional toll that hospital workers have endured in caring for patients during the pandemic has, among other issues, exacerbated the shortage." Even before the pandemic, the emerging shortage forced hospitals to contract expensive temporary workforce alternatives with little opportunity for culture acclimation or long-term engagement. Sustaining a large portion of the healthcare workforce with temporary contract workers is not a viable, long-term solution.

The Solution

Working with partners, business leaders and individuals who share our dedication to this region, we are creating new opportunities for talented and diverse Gaston area students by training them for health-related jobs in Gaston County.

Emphasizing the individual and collective strength of a talented and well-trained workforce, we envision developing an even stronger culture of support for a team-based approach to problem-solving and ongoing multimodal learning. From innovative high school programs to graduate specialty credentials, the CaroMont Health Cares Campaign envisions a robust network of education and training designed to ensure the future of health and wellness for the people of the Greater Gaston community and surrounding areas.



Through the campaign scholarship initiative, we will significantly increase the availability of scholarships and financial support for area residents. Employees and students preparing for healthcare careers at CaroMont Health currently have several options regarding their career paths. Pending their potential career interests and circumstances, education and training can be obtained from on-the-job-training, technical colleges, two-year community colleges, four-year colleges and universities, and apprenticeship programs.

Addressing four areas of focus, current CaroMont Health Career Pathways are grouped by services:

PATIENT CARE SERVICES

Registered Nurse (RN), Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) 1, Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) 2, Surgical Technician

HEALTH INFORMATICS

Data Analyst, Medical Records Technician, IT Programmer

DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES

Cardiovascular Technologist, Nuclear Medical Technologist, Radiology Technician, Ultrasound Technician

SUPPORT SERVICES

Dietary Technician, Facilities Maintenance, Food Service, Environmental Care Technician

Anticipating future scholarships in all four health science career paths, existing workforce shortages require that our immediate focus is directed to recruiting and training RNs, LPNs and CNAs. These positions comprise more than 30 percent of the urgent workforce needs at CaroMont Health.

Fully funded, the campaign scholarship initiative anticipates supporting as many as 130 scholarship recipients. Generally ranging between \$500 and \$12,000 annually, individual scholarship awards may vary based on the choice of an academic program, program priority as determined by CaroMont Health, recipient need and recipient merit.

To ensure the future of a talented and diverse healthcare workforce in Gaston County, affiliations with local education partners are essential. Gaston College, Belmont Abbey College and Gaston County Schools will serve as key education affiliates in the initial phase of the campaign scholarship initiative. As the program progresses in scope, we anticipate including additional affiliate relationships.

CaroMont Health Cares Campaign scholarship recipients will be required to make a two-year commitment to work at a CaroMont Health facility upon graduation. Their commitment will be backed by a two-year promissory note should they decide not to stay with CaroMont Health. Statistically, employees who work at least two years at CaroMont Health are more likely to remain in the system over a longer period. Two years allows time for new employees to develop a sense of appreciation for the culture and mission of the CaroMont Health organization.
